

**PINCONNING AREA SCHOOLS
BOARD OF EDUCATION
Regular Meeting
August 10, 2020**

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of Pinconning Area Schools was held virtually via Google Meet on Monday, August 10, 2020. Public viewing was available via YouTube stream. Request for public comment was posted in advance.

President Coutcher called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. President Coutcher led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present: Linda Anderson, Mike Bauer, Mark Coutcher, Paul Pomaville, Chris Rabish, and Nicole Jones, (Jera Klimek absent).

Moved by Bauer, supported by Jones, to approve the agenda as presented.
Voice Vote: Motion carried (6-0).

There were no community comments.

Moved by Bauer, supported by Jones, to approve the consent agenda:

Mike Vieau, Superintendent of Schools, discussed the Return to Learn Plan for the District and thanked the ISD for working with our District on this plan. He also talked about the Virtual Learning Plan which he directed the public to visit on the PASD website which explains the plan in more detail. He stated at this time 10% of PASD students have signed up for the virtual learning plan. Mike gave an update on PPE cleaning supplies and thanked Kris McLavy for getting the supplies in house and ready for the opening of school. He also recognized Cathy Montiega and the Wednesday Craft Group along with Robert and Stephanie Broderick, for donating a large quantity of masks to the Pinconning Area School District. Mike mentioned that the Opening Day Activities will be held virtually on August 25, 2020.

Joel Strasz, Bay County Health Department representative, provided the Board with an update on the current Covid-19 pandemic. He also offered assistance in developing the safety plan for staff and students returning to school.

Administrators had an opportunity to present reports. Kyle Woodruff, Middle/High School Principal, talked about providing information to the parents about the opening of school and getting the students back in school safely. Christine Schwerin, Linwood Elementary Principal, explained how our District will provide Google and Seesaw

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training in partnership with ISD and Mark Lyons. Parents can attend live and the sessions will be recorded and posted to our website for parents to access for those who can't attend.

Moved by Bauer, supported by Jones, to adopt the Community Eligibility Provision program for grades K-12 for the 2020-21 school year as presented.
